

Camilla Palumbo was born in Rome in 1969. In 1995 she graduated in Biological Sciences, *magna cum laude*, at the University Sapienza of Rome. In 1997 she was a research fellow at the Department of Cell biology, University of Nijmegen (NL). She then received her Ph.D. in Experimental Medicine from the University of L'Aquila and obtained the degree of Specialist in Clinical Pathology at the University Sapienza of Rome. Since 2008 is a researcher of General Pathology at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Rome Tor Vergata. She has published more than 20 peer-reviewed papers, has been a reviewer of manuscripts for *Haematologica*, *Biologics: targets & therapy* and the *Journal of Leukocyte Biology* and a reviewer of grant applications for the British Lung Foundation and Breast Cancer Campaign. Her main research interests embrace: the role of cytokine/growth factor receptors and extracellular matrix molecules and the effects of differentiating and pharmacological agents on tumor cell behavior, with a special focus on malignant pleural mesothelioma; the study of molecular mediators of axon-Schwann cell interactions in inherited demyelinating neuropathies. She teaches General Pathology at the School of Physiotherapy, University of Tor vergata.

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
